Open House is on December 6th for Sophomores and Community members. Please share this with others interested in attending Auburn. If you would like time to speak with your child's teacher please call for an appointment.

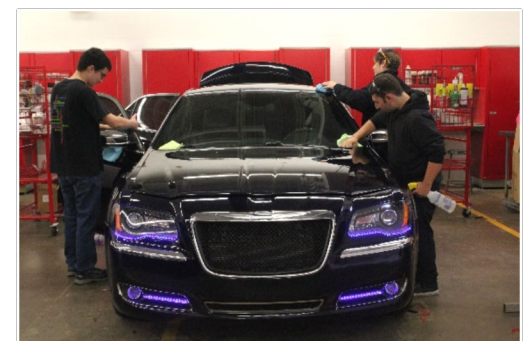
