Criteria to be considered in the choice of Scholarship Recipients

1. A senior class member of Riverside, Fairport Harding, Harvey High Schools or Auburn Career Center, residing in the Painesville Township School District, Painesville City School District or the Fairport Harbor School District
2. Minimum accumulative grade point average of 3.0 for the first seven (7) semesters of high school
3. A letter of recommendation from two faculty members
4. Completion of typed application by April 23, 2018
5. Submission of transcript of credit
6. Evidence of acceptance at an accredited two or four year college or university, or an accredited trade or business school

A check for the scholarship will be mailed to the recipient if the recipient is not present at the scholarship luncheon to be held on June 7, 2018. The check will be made payable to the student.
