



Emergency Services Telecommunicator Scholarship

Funding

The funding for this scholarship is provided by the Lake County Clerk of Courts and Lake County Commissioners and is intended for students enrolling into the Emergency Services Telecommunicator program.

Eligibility

- Students who pass the WorkKeys Assessment for this program and complete all enrollment requirements including, but not limited to, the BCI background check and specified drug screen unless the student is an employee of a business that covers the cost of the program before, during, or after the program.
- This scholarship is considered a “last-dollar” funding source in relation to funding received from the Veteran’s Administration (VA). If the VA pays for the student’s program, no scholarship will be awarded. If the VA only pays for a portion of the program, the scholarship will be prorated accordingly.
- Funding that the student may receive or may have received, such as from a Jobs and Family Services agency or under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, will be taken into consideration when determining the scholarship amount.
- Students who are family members of employees and receiving 100% free tuition for a program can receive up to 50% off the non-tuition expenses. If the student is a family member and receiving 50% off the tuition, the student may receive up to 25% off the non-tuition expenses.

Guidelines

- If awarded, the scholarship can only be applied directly to the student’s account at Auburn Career Center.
- Awards may be given in up to two disbursements.
- If the student withdraws from the program, he/she may not receive the entire scholarship amount.
- Scholarship awards cannot be used to pay off previous account balances at Auburn Career Center.
- Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress and meet attendance requirements as stated in current Auburn Career Center’s Adult Workforce Education Student Handbook or the Emergency Services Telecommunicator Student Handbook.
- Awards are based on Adult Workforce Education staff recommendations and at the discretion of the Auburn Education Foundation Board of Directors. Decisions cannot be appealed or petitioned.

Scholarship Amount

The scholarship amount will be determined based on the need of the student and the amount of Emergency Services Telecommunicator grant available but not to exceed:

- 50% of all program costs
